

# Sit on it and swivel

Pete Moore gives us the low down on the new idleback chair, which could be the must have accessory for 2009 and beyond

I had heard rumours of the new idleback chair from the CLA, so I decided to find out what it was all about. The design offers a fully traversable field shooting seat and consists of a strong, adjustable tripod base with an upper, 360° assembly that incorporates a seat pad, reversible back support for left handers and height/angle adjustable rifle rest with a tilt/swivel head.

Strong enough to take even my lard butt; you set the chair up, sit in and adjust your position and hey presto you have what is akin to an open turret. For traverse you simply use your legs with the rifle rest assembly providing good adjustment and a rock solid firing platform.

Reasonably light and portable the idleback chair can be used on the ground, from the cargo area of an open-backed truck or even a large tower-type high seat. For those long bunny busting sessions or just waiting for that

shy fox it provides a practical and versatile shooting platform. Priced at under £300 the cost is very good considering the high build quality and sheer innovation of the product. I now

have one to test and can't wait to get it out in the field, as it looks very clever...
